

Guidelines on reserve of epidemic-prevention supplies for non-residential facilities (other than nurseries and day care centers)

I. When the alert level of influenza pandemic is set at 2 or lower, non-residential facilities (other than nurseries and day care centers) are to stock up epidemic-prevention supplies in accordance to the following guidelines.

Stock of epidemic-prevention supplies:

Non-residential facilities (other than nurseries and day care centers) should have a sufficient stock of epidemic-prevention supplies (e.g. disposable protective clothing/gown, disposable latex gloves, disposable plastic apron, disposable cap, shoe cover and protective goggles) for their daily operation besides the required quantity as specified in the following guidelines.

Guidelines on reserve of epidemic-prevention supplies for non-residential facilities (other than nurseries and day care centers)

> Stock of cleansers and disinfectants:

The facilities must have a stock of disinfectants (e.g. alcohol and bleach) that lasts for over 14 days.

II. When the MSAR government has raised the alert level of influenza pandemic from 2 to 3 or higher, non-residential facilities (other than nurseries and day care centers) are to stock up sufficient epidemic-prevention supplies that can last for 30 days.

Stock of epidemic-prevention supplies for 30 days:

Non-residential facilities (other than nurseries and day care centers) should have a sufficient stock of epidemic-prevention supplies (e.g. disposable protective clothing/gown, disposable latex gloves, disposable plastic apron, disposable cap, shoe cover and protective goggles) for their daily operation besides the required quantity as specified in the following guidelines.

> Stock of cleansers and disinfectants:

The facilities must have a stock of disinfectants (e.g. alcohol and bleach) that lasts for 30 days.

When there is an outbreak of a major epidemic disease, non residential facilities (other than nurseries and day care centers) are to adjust their stock of epidemic-prevention supplies according to the latest guidelines provided by the Health Bureau of Macao.
